## GYMNASTICS

### Rules & Policies

1. All students must be properly attired in gymnastics clothing. Girls must wear leotard, hair up in neat ponytail. No Jewelry, other than post earrings. Boys attire : T-shirt and shorts. No buttons or zippers.
2. Make-up classes are allowed only in a current session. Classes not made up in the current session are forfeited. They cannot be transferred to the next session.
3. Tuition is due by the 28th of each month. Split and late payments not paid on time will incur a 10% late fee after the 1st of the month.
4. Absolutely no chewing gum, beverages, food or jewelry are allowed in the gym.
5. No unregistered parents or children are allowed in the designated gym area.
6. Undisciplined or misbehaved students will be dismissed from the gym for safety reasons.
7. Parents are prohibited to talk to students or give instructions from the waiting area. All comments are to be passed through the front office.
8. No refunds for unused services. Make up classes must be scheduled through the front desk, not the coaches.
9. All students must have a current , paid, annual registration fee to participate.
10. Nova Gymnastics is not a babysitting service. Siblings are not allowed to remain at the gym alone while you leave the facility.
11. No Video or Photography is allowed in designated gym areas.
12. Gymnasts and Coaches are prohibited from using cell phones on the gym floor.
13. Any negative comments or gossip about the gym, coaches, staff members, or team members or any persons related to Nova Gymnastics , inside or outside the gym will not be tolerated and will result in dismissal from the gym.
14. Private lessons must be scheduled and paid for through the front desk . Must be a full time registered student.
15. No pets allowed anywhere in the gym.
16. No smoking or alcoholic beverages.
17. Late pick-ups will be charged a late fee of \$20 for every hour. (To be charged to your account)
18. No verbal or physical violence is permitted in any areas of Nova Gymnastics.
